Upon successful completion, student will be issued with a statement of attainment for **22024VIC Course in the Emergency Management of Asthma in the Workplace** issued by Training Aid Australia (RTOID 91411).

Who should undertake this course?

In a move to improve emergency response training in early childhood education institutions, new legislation specifies that there must be a staff member onsite at all times with current accredited Asthma, Anaphylaxis and First Aid training. Training should be renewed annually to maintain staff skills in the workplace.
